

Student Satisfaction Survey

The Student Satisfaction Survey introduced by NAAC helps the institution to evaluate its performance based on students' opinions about pedagogical practices and institutional operations. On the basis of the survey the following facts were clearly drawn :

Students are generally satisfied with teaching skills of the faculty. Many of the students felt that teachers did justice to the course. But they would appreciate teachers further if there was more communication between them and students and help weak students by solving their difficulties individually. They also desired teaching with more life examples to make the course interesting and desirable, showing preference for the practical rather than the theoretical knowledge.

Some of the areas that needed changes according to the survey were

1. Increase the use of ICT and multimedia tools
2. Upgradation of computers in computer labs
3. Teaching of syllabi according to industry demands and not from the point of view of examinations
4. Increase career counselling and guidance programmes
5. Need of placement drives
6. Introduce soft skills and communication skill programmes
