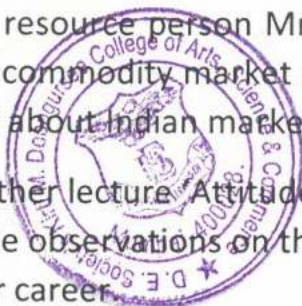
**BAF**

He also donated blood at the BMC blood bank. Prof. Lalita Salvi and her friends helped needy people in her area with COVID-19 kits which contained Sanitizers, Masks, Grocery items, etc. TYBA Geography student Omkar Gole voluntarily distributed food kits to factory workers. He participated in 11<sup>th</sup> Mass Screening program at Ramabai Nagar, Ghatkopar as well as Chembur during 10/06/2020 to 21/06/2020 and became COVID warrior. He volunteered to draw social distancing circles in front of essential goods shops in Village Road area, Bhandup.

On 03/03/2021, One Day National Webinar on the theme "Tourism in India: Explore the Unexplored" was organized by Dept. of Geography, convened by Prof. Vrushali Bhalerao. This webinar was massive success and was attended by participants across 25 states all over India. Feedback for this program was received from more than 550 participants. Many unexplored locations from various parts of India were highlighted and the participants had active interaction with the speakers. This



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webinar was very informative for the students as it was based on their syllabus topic.

On 17/03/2021, Guest lecture on "Mapping Essentials – A case study of Forests in Konkan Region" by Prof. Dr. Prakash Dongre, Associate Professor, Dept. of Geography, N. K. College, Malad was conducted on the occasion of World Forest Day. It was attended by more than 85 students. This lecture raised awareness about the importance of all types of forests in keeping the ecological balance. It also helped to understand essential techniques of map making using QGIS software.

On 09/05/2021, Alumni meet was arranged in order to interact with Alumni and establish connection and networking between current students, staff members and past graduates. It was attended by 34 past students.

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## ECONOMICS

**AARTHIK PRERNA:** Two webinars on Contemporary Socio-economic Issues were jointly organized by Department of Economics and BMS, Kirti College for Degree college students. These webinars were organized under the aegis of SRUJAN: An Annual Academic Festival organized by IQAC.

a) **National Level Webinar:** Under Aarthik Prerna, a National level webinar was organized on Human Development Issues and Recent Developments in Banking Sector on 16/02/2021. Dr Sandhya Iyer, Associate Professor, TISS, Mumbai was the resource person for first session. She made a research based critical assessment of India growth story since 1991. 'Economic Growth and Human Development Challenges in India: Outcomes in Post-Economic Reforms Period'. She stressed upon the need for micro level development strategies rather than one size fits all approach to expand employment opportunities and reduced income inequalities. Dr. Sandhya also pitched for investment in education and health for long term sustained economic development and better quality of life. Her presentation and question answer session was well received by more than 200 participants from Mumbai, Maharashtra, West Bengal, Assam, Bangalore and New Delhi.


The speaker of second session was Mr Indreel Pandit Vice-President, Federal Bank Ltd. He spoke about the Recent Trends in Banking Sector. He underlined the significance and disruptions brought by financial technology and artificial intelligence in the banking sector. Post demonetization, banking sector and financial technology companies have huge data trail as a result, the traditional banking system is hugely challenged by fin tech firms. Mr. Pandit's session was very interactive as well. He honestly answered different kinds of question with a calm and composed mind.

b) **Guest Lecture on 'Financial Inclusion: Need of the Hour'** was conducted on 20/02/ 2021. Mr Devdatta Dhanokar (Certified Financial Planner) was the resource person. Mr. Dhanokar stressed upon the need to understand the significance of portfolio management and financial planning at a young age. He expressed that the student community needs to be well versed with financial literacy and inculcate habit of financial management. The question answer session was highly fruitful.
