

7.1.9 - Sensitization of students and employees of the Institution to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens

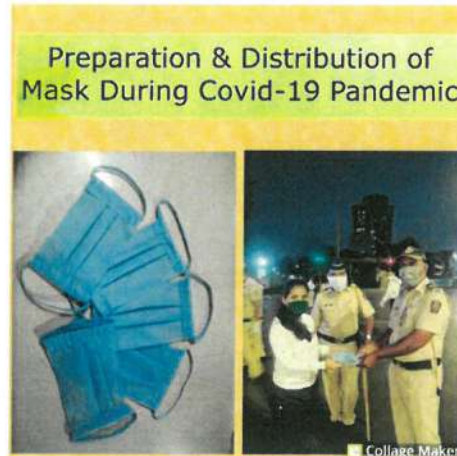
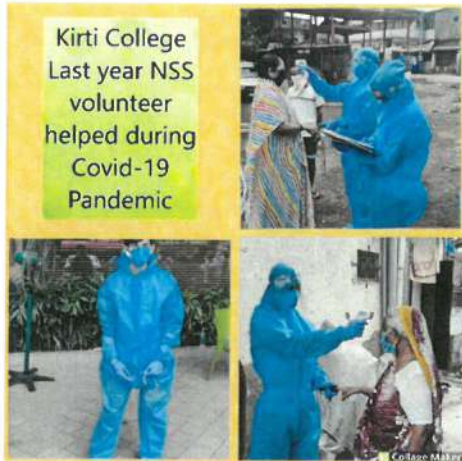
- When the city of Mumbai was battling with COVID -19 pandemic, staff and students in many departments came to the fore to provide their services. They supplied food kits and ration to needy families for six to seven months. One of the staff organized and conducted COVID-19 screening tests for people in Sion area. Some of the staff donated blood at the BMC blood bank. Many staff members helped needy people in their area with COVID-19 kits which contained sanitizers, masks, grocery items, etc. and by paying tuition fees of needy students. As Covid warriors, students voluntarily distributed food kits to factory workers, participated in mass screening programmes, drew social distancing circles in front of essential goods shop, etc. 32 cadets participated in an inter-company poster and video making competitions organized online by NCC on 22/04/2021 to spread awareness about COVID-19. Attractive and meaningful messages and videos were posted on their social media account.
- Cadets participated in International Day against drug abuse and illicit trafficking on 26/06/2020 . Posters were designed to create awareness on treacherous effects of drug abuse and illicit trafficking in a Poster competition .
- 26 cadets participated in a Poster competition conducted on 10/12/2020 on Human rights.
- Cadets participated in blood donation activity organized by Kirti college along with K. E. M. hospital and Jagjivan Ram hospital, Parel at Dadar railway station on 11/02/2021.
- Joy of giving activities was carried out near Dadar station area on 02/03/2021. 10 Cadets distributed food to poor people following covid protocols.
- In their pursuit of environmental conservation in an innovative manner, Cadets prepared and distributed seedballs to be planted besides sapling plantation on 06/06/2020 at different locations in Mumbai.
- Lectures on preservation of mangroves and importance of coral reefs were organized online on 03/02/2021 and 11/03/2021 respectively to spread awareness of nature's gifts to mankind and the need for their conservation.
- An attempt has been made to create a butterfly garden in the campus.
- A beach cleaning involving Kirti College NCC Cadets in collaboration with Siddharth College was organised at Girgaon Chowpatty on 14th December, 2020.
- An awareness webinar was organised for students on 04/11/2020 to foster digital empowerment, a safe cyber experience and ensure mental well-being in cyber space.
- An informative lecture on "The Sexual Harassment Of Women (Prevention, Prohibition And Redressal) Act, 2013" on 04/11/2020 addressed the role of Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) in implementation of the policies relating to the prevention of sexual harassment, and its redressal at the work place. The lecture also discussed provisions of the POSH Act 2013.
- An online workshop "Building Digital Guardians", was conducted on 06/11/2020 for parents to train them in safe guarding their child online by equipping them as proactive digital guardians.
- An online workshop on IPR was organised on 03/04/2021

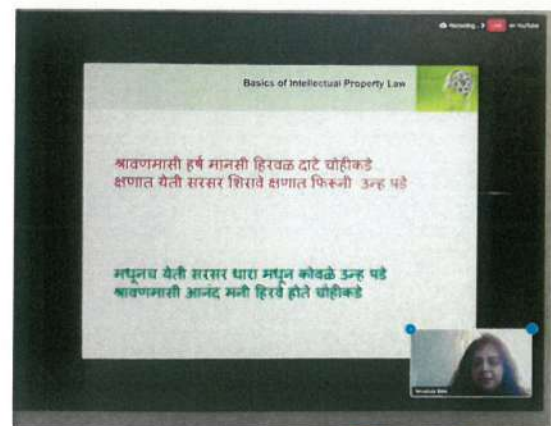
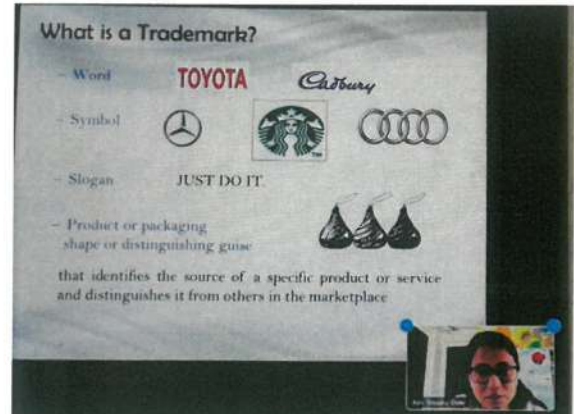

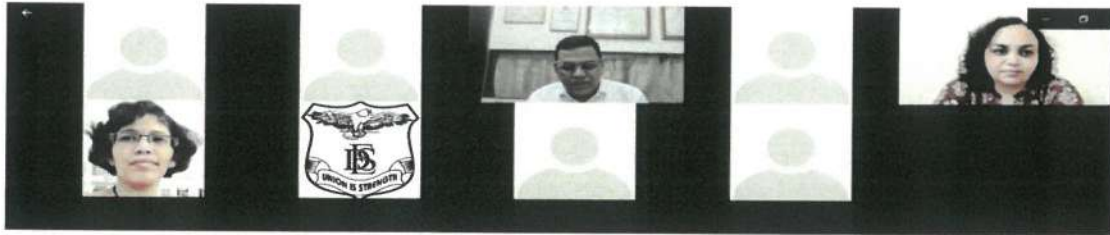
