## **ABOUT AUTONOMOUS STATUS**

UGC has conferred the Autonomous Status to our college 'D.E. Society's Kirti M. Doongursee College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Dadar, Mumbai' in June 2022 (dt.16<sup>th</sup> June, 2022) for the duration of 10 years from Academic Year 2022-23 to AY 2031-32. Subsequently, on 21<sup>st</sup> June 2022, University of Mumbai also intimated us about conferment of autonomous status by UGC.

The College is looking at Autonomy as an opportunity to offer the programme with greater flexibility and relevance, with a view to further improve the quality of education and for achieving academic excellence. The College continues to be affiliated to the University of Mumbai. So, the degrees will be awarded to the students by the University based on the recommendation of the College. The name of the College will be mentioned in the Degree Certificates.

Further, in compliance with the UGC notification dated 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2018 regarding autonomy we have initiated the process implementation.

Accordingly, at the Academic Council meeting held on 01<sup>st</sup> September, 2023, the following resolutions were passed.

1. The syllabi for the First year UG and PG under NEP 2020 for faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce, and self-financed course BAMMC, BAF, BMS, BIOTECH, CS, IT department were adopted and were to be presented in the upcoming Governing body meeting.

2. The examination pattern and evaluation pattern of Major and Minor verticals was presented and sought their suggestions and approval.

The above listed minutes of Academic Council held on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2023 was confirmed in the meeting of Governing Body held on 30<sup>th</sup> October, 2023.

The subsequent Academic Council meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2024; the following resolutions were passed.

1. The syllabi for the Second year under NEP 2020 for faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce, and self-financed course BAMMC, BAF, BMS, BIOTECH, CS, IT departments for UG and PG & PG Department of Data Science as sanctioned in BOS of respective department was approved unanimously.

2. The existing syllabi of University of Mumbai for third year for faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce and self-financed courses BAMMC, BAF, BMS, BIOTECH, CS, IT department with subject to changes in evaluation pattern (60:40) as sanctioned in BOS of respective departments, approved unanimously.

3. The NEP 2020 syllabi was approved for the First year for faculties of Arts, Science, Commerce and self-financed courses BAMMC, BAF, BMS, BIOTECH, CS, IT departments for UG & PG as sanctioned in BOS of respective departments with changes in verticals as per Circular of University of Mumbai.

4. The new PG course M. Com in Advanced Accountancy from the academic year 2024-2025 was approved.

5. The syllabi, examination pattern and evaluation pattern of co-curricular courses (CC) such as Dance, Music, Yoga, Sports, Marathi Theatre, NSS, and social work were approved unanimously.

6. The examination pattern and evaluation pattern of Major and Minor verticals approved unanimously.

7. The Passing standards & Regulations regarding evaluation process for the First Year UG & PG as sanctioned by Board of Examination from the academic 2024-2025 were approved.

The above listed minutes of the Academic Council held on 25<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 was confirmed in the meeting of the Governing Body held on 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2024.

The Finance Committee meeting was held on 15<sup>th</sup> June, 2023; the following resolutions were passed.
